## AMENDMENT TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT

This Amendment is made to the Grant Agreement ("the Agreement") dated 12/27/2023

The EFCSN and the Beneficiary entered into an agreement on 12/27/2023

The EFCSN intends to allocate additional funding to the Beneficiary from the remaining project funds as a grant to acknowledge their participation and contributions to the project's implementation.

Therefore, the Grant Agreement is amended as follows:

## **Article 1: Amendments**

A paragraph 5 is added after paragraph 4 of Article 1:

- 5. The EFCSN agrees to allocate the remaining funds from the project budget, amounting to
- 4,268.61 € (four thousand two hundred sixty-eight euros and sixty-one cents)

to the Beneficiary as an additional grant.
